### Early Investigation

- **×** Reports
- **▼** Inspect and photograph
- **×** Interview
- **×** Locate the vehicle
- **▼** Conduct vehicle inspection
- ⋆ Obtain medical records
- **▼** Obtain weather reports
- **▼** Obtain driver's history
- **▼** Obtain vehicle history



#### Discovery

- **★** Additional culpable parties?
- **➤** Preliminary discovery request
  - To confirm claim of defect:
    - Design vs manufacturing
    - Repair or maintenance
    - Mechanical or electrical systems
    - After-market parts
  - To confirm damages claims:
    - Personal injury
    - Emotional distress
    - Property damage
    - Punitive damage





- **▼** Consider requesting other incident evidence
- **▼** Depose the driver and all passengers and witnesses
- **➤** Depose investigating officer
- **▼** Depose first responders
- **▼** Depose plaintiff, spouse and medical providers



#### Expert Issues

- **▼** Identify and retain appropriate experts
  - Supply all relevant materials
  - Is additional discovery necessary?
  - Consider testing
- **▼** Depose plaintiff's experts

  - **▼** Trial motions to file:
    - Motions to preclude experts
    - Evidentiary motions
    - Bifurcation of liability and damages
    - Motions to strike punitive damage claims
